Grant Development and Fundraising Committee:

- The board will be starting the process soon for the application on the DCED grant
- A date will be established for the fundraising and grants committee to meet soon.
- Board Member, Charlie Jones reached out to The Luzerne Foundation to inquire about using them as a conduit for the funds received from the ARPA grant. The board feels that this would be beneficial because it would provide additional oversight for the funds (at no cost) and allow organizations to write off donations. The board has not decided to go this route but is strongly considering the option.
- The board addressed concerns from council members about advancements versus reimbursement from the ARPA grant. Board member Ryan Binkley will reach out to his contact for the grant to gather more information.
- Board member Ryan Binkley organized the list of projects sketched out in the ARPA grant along with information about where we are in the planning process, actions needed, and amount budgeted.

Mayor's Hometown Celebration

- Several board members along with members from Borough Council expressed concerns about the lack of information available for this event along with the scope being outside of what was originally applied for.
- The Rec Board invited Mayor Concert to the meeting to discuss the event and answer questions.
- Questions that council and the board inquired about:
- Is the event a borough event and if so, will vendors be supplying their own insurance/liability insurance?
- How many people are expected to attend?
- What sorts of activities will be available?
- Getting the field ready for the Sailors is a top priority for the Board but is dependent on bids and weather, the Board informed the mayor that there is a small chance the field may not be accessible the day of his event. This was

something we had not foreseen when we approved the request. As such, we asked the mayor if he could not hold his event that day if he wanted to have a designated space at the Wing Fling Festival to hold his celebration, he declined stating that he preferred to keep the events separate.

To conclude, the Board requested that The Mayor file additional paperwork with the details and information that the Board and Council were requesting. The mayor agreed to fill out the form once it was sent to him.
